

मोहफूल लाहेरी संकलनासाठी जंगल परिसरात गेलेल्या युवकावर अस्वलाने हल्ला चढविला. अस्वलाच्या हल्ल्यामध्ये युवक गंभीर जखमी झाला. अस्वलाने टोकदार नखांनी संपूर्ण चेहऱ्याला ओखडल्यामुळे त्या युवकाचा चेहरा छिन्नविछिन्न झाल्याने तो जगणार की नाही, याबाबत शंका उपस्थित केली येथील लोकविरादरी प्रकल्पाच्या दवाखान्यात डॉ. दिगंत आमटे वांनी शतींचे प्रवल करून त्या युवकायर अस्वलाचे मानवायरील हल्ले होत

उपचार केल्याने अखेर त्याचा जीव वाचला

२०२२ रोजी शिवाजी पुंगाटी हा युवक मोहफूल संकलनासाठी गावापासून काही अंतरावर असलेल्या जंगलात गेला होता.

शिवाजीवर अस्वलाने हल्ला चढविला. यामध्ये शिवाजी गंभीर जखमी झाला. अस्वलाच्या नखांमळे घायाळ झालेल्या शिवाजी चेहरा छिन्नविद्यन बाला होता गावापासून १८ ते २० किमी अंतरावरील आरोग्य केंद्रात त्याला खाटेवरून प्रवास करित

चेहरा आणि डोळ्यांना जबर मार असल्यामळे उपचार होणे कठीण होते. त्यामुळे आरोग्य केंद्रात प्राथमिक उपचार करून पुढील उपचारासाठी समोर पाठविले. त्याला चंद्रपूर येथील रुग्णालवात दाखल करण्यात आले. मात्र, पूर्ण उपचार झाले नाहीत. यानंतर त्याला नागपुर येथेही पाठविण्यात आल्वाची माहिती आहे. परंतु त्वा ठिकाणी सुध्दा नीट उपचार झाले नाहीत. आर्थिक पाठबळ नसल्याने त्याला परत भामरागडला आणण्यात आले.

जिल्हा परिषदेचे माजी सदस्य ॲड. लालस् नागोटी वांना

असतात. २८ मार्च दाखल करण्यात आले. परंतु, माहिती मिळाली. त्यांनी रुग्णाच्या नातेवाईकांशी संपर्क करित शिवाजीला लोकविरादरी प्रकल्पाच्या दवाखान्यात उपचारसाठी दाखल केले. यावेळी रुग्णाची जखम पूर्णतः पिकली होती. परंतु, डॉ. दिगंत आमटे यांनी शतींचे प्रयत्न करत त्याच्यावर उपचार सरू केले. तब्बल दोन महिन्यांपर्यंत त्या रुग्णावर उपचार सुरू ठेवले. त्यामुळे आज शिवाजी जिवंत आहे. अस्वलाच्या हल्ल्यामळे शिवाजीचा एक डोळा जायबंदी ज्ञाला असला तरी, लोकविरादरी प्रकल्पातील दवाखान्यामुळे आज जीवंत असल्याचे समाधान त्याच्या चेहऱ्यावर दिसन येते.

Safe and readily available water is a basic need for public health whether it is used for drinking, domestic use, food production, sanitation etc. It helps to improve economy & quality of living in villages. Keeping in mind that & by demand of tribals in Palli village, Lok Biradari Prakalp facilitated the construction of borewell for water. Villagers provided the land for borewell with the consensus in village meeting on 16th June 2022. Mr. Ashok Gaikwad & Mr. Shreedhar Madavi from Lok Biradari Prakalp coordinated the process.

Dr. Anagha Amte a gynaecologist from Lok Biradari Hospital conducted a light hearted interactive session about menstrual hygiene management with the tribal women. She demonstrated the process of menstruation cycle & ways to maintain hygiene during it using 'menstrual cup' along with traditional ways on a life sized model. The participants found to be keen to know more about this newer method & interested in adopting it soon. The initiative is sponsored by Rotary club of Bolton Lever, Turton Rotary club and Bolton le Moors Rotary club.

Sickle cell screening camp

Quarterly sickle cell clinic was conducted on 22nd of June 2022 in collaboration with Hemoglobinopathies Satelite Centr, National Institute of Immunohaematology (ICMR), Chandrapur at LBP Hospital, Hemalkasa. Dr. Kalpita Gavit, Mr. Prajyot Deshmukh & Mr.Zakir from ICMR visited hemalkasa for the clinic. Suspected & detected cases of Sickle cell anemia & thallasemia were clinically examined & provided by needful treatment. Counselling were given to the patients & their relatives.

Blood Pressure & Oral Health screening camp at Hodri village in Bhamragad was conducted on 15th June 2022. Villagers enthusiastically gathered for the camp early morning. A medical officer Dr.Vikas Junghare, Dentist Dr.Shriram, Nurse Sangita Widpi, community health worker Birju Kadanga & Community Health Coordinator Dr.Aditya conducted the camp with the help of volunteers from village itself. Screening of 72 patients done for blood pressure & 28 patients were screened for oral health. Needful medications & counselling provided at camp and referred at LBP hospital for treatment.





Blood Donation Camp

Community Awareness Meeting

Community awareness meeting arranged at remote village Midadapalli about malaria as a pre-monsoon activity. The village is selected as it has prevalence of Malaria cases which many a times becomes fatal due to lack of government health system support. Villagers shown a short educational video film made at Lok Biradari Prakalp about Malaria. It further followed by discussion with villagers regarding their understanding about malaria, preventive activities they are using & their needs for prevention. Community health workers Sunita Majji & Pali Mahaka from LBP facilitated the meeting.
